Health Professionals and Support Services Award 2010 and Nurses Award 2010 - substantive issues.

- [1] Pursuant to section 594 of the Fair Work Act 2009 (Cth), it is ordered that:
- 1. Subject to 2 and 3, access to APESMA-1, APESMA-2 and APESMA-3, along with the attachments to those exhibits, is granted to:
 - a. the officers and employees of ABI who may be or become involved in the proceedings in any respect;
 - b. the officers and employees of NSWBC who may be or become involved in the proceedings in any respect;
 - c. the legal representatives of ABI and NSWBC instructed to appear in the proceedings; and
 - d. secretarial staff in the ordinary course of the provision of administrative assistance to the legal representatives of ABI and NSWBC, subject to being informed of the terms of this Order.
- 2. The names and/or addresses of the witnesses whose evidence is the subject of APESMA-1, APESMA-2 or APESMA-3 must not be published or otherwise disclosed.
- 3. The information contained in APESMA-1, APESMA-2 or APESMA-3 must not be used for any purpose other than these proceedings.
