We refer to the above proceedings and confirm that we act for the Australian Dental Association (ADA) in respect of this matter.

The ADA requests that the timetable of the above proceedings be amended to allow for an extension of time.

The reason for the ADA's request is that it has only recently became aware the directions issued on 28 August 2019. We note that the correspondence from the Chambers of Deputy President Booth to the parties on 28 August 2019 indicated that the directions were to be published online. A representative of the ADA was later made aware that the directions were accessible through a hyperlink embedded in that correspondence, rather than on the Fair Work Commission website. As a consequence, the ADA has had limited time to prepare for the next stage in the proceedings.

Given the above, the ADA respectfully requests that the timetable be amended as a follows:

- 1. By no later than 4pm on Monday 14 October 2019, any interested party is to file submissions, with witness statements and other material upon which it seeks to rely in relation to the matter of whether the List of Common Health Professionals contained in Schedule C of the Award should be indicative or exhaustive.
- 2. By no later than 4pm on Monday 11 November 2019, any interested party is to file a response to the material filed pursuant to point 1 above, including any objection to the admission of evidence with reasons.
- 3. If relevant, by no later than 4pm on Monday 11 November 2019, any interested party is to file an application to be represented by a lawyer or paid agent in accordance with s.596 of the Fair Work Act 2009 (Cth).



- 4. By no later than **4pm on Monday 25 November 2019**, any interested party is to file a reply to the submissions filed in accordance with point 2 above, including any reply to any objection to the admission of evidence, with reasons.
- 5. If relevant, by no later than **4pm on Monday 25 November 2019**, any interested party is to file a response to any other party's application to be represented by a lawyer or paid agent in accordance with s.596 of the *Fair Work Act 2009* (Cth).

The ADA has received consent from the majority of the parties in this matter to the proposed amendments to the directions. The ADA has left a message with Australian Business Limited (ABL) seeking their consent to the amendments, but has not received confirmation of the agreement of ABL. We do not anticipate any objections from ABL to the amended directions.
