We refer to the Decision of the Full Bench [2020] FWCFB 5275 (6 October 2020) ("the Decision").

At paragraphs [58] – [60] of the Decision, the Full Bench set out its conclusions with respect to clause 25.3 (Payment of Wages on Termination) of the Timber Award. This included a redrafted proposed clause in light of the consent position reached between the main industrial parties, AIG, CFMMEU, AMWU and ABI & NSWBC (the Full Bench's provisional view).

The CFMMEU has reviewed the matter and indicates its support for the Full Bench's provisional view outlined at paragraph [60].
