I refer to the matter above and the directions to file further submissions in the matter by 4.00 pm today. The ASU has endeavoured to have its submissions and evidence ready in accordance with the Commission's directions, but we will not be in a position to do so. We respectfully request leave to file out of time, but no later than 9.00 am tomorrow morning.

We are unable to comply with the Directions, due to unforeseen events over the past weeks:

- Firstly, at different times over the past month all Australian domestic airlines have stood down a significant
 proportion of their workforce. The ASU's national industrial team has been occupied with an unusual
 number of consultation meetings and other activity to support our members in the Airline Industry.
- Secondly, the NSW Government has implemented public health orders that place strict rules around the
 work of our members in disability and mental health. This includes limitations on their ability to leave the 12
 Local Government Areas of Concern and a required to have receive at least one dose of a COVID-19 vaccine
 before 31 August. NSW is a significant areas of membership for the ASU in the SCHDS industry. Responding
 to these challenges has occupied a significant proportion of the ASU NSW Branch's resources, limiting their
 ability to participate in the preparation of our case and provide instructions.

We apologise for making this request so late in the day. We had hoped to be in a position to comply with the directions.
