I refer to the above matter and the conciliation conference that was held yesterday before Commissioner Lee.

As a result of the conciliation, discussions are still ongoing between the parties in respect of a number of the claims that are currently listed for hearing.

It was raised during the conciliation that the Amended Directions dated 11 July 2019 require filing by parties in relation to certain claims by 3 September 2019. Given that this date is fast approaching and discussions are still ongoing in relation to the claims, parties respectfully request a further amendment to the Amended Directions.

Please see <u>attached</u> further amended directions with the proposed variations in red. Parties consented to this variation following the conciliation, and I confirm that all parties are copied into this correspondence.

I also note that there is an error in the Amended Directions of 11 July 2019 which require parties to respond to all outstanding union claims by 3 September 2019 (direction 7). The majority of those claims were responded to on 12 July 2019, and the only remaining outstanding union claims that are to be responded to from that section are those claims relating to travel. This issue has been rectified with the insertion of a new direction 7 in the **attached** directions.
