4 yearly review of modern awards – Social, Community, Home Care and Disability Services Industry Award 2010 – Tranche 2.

- [1] To assist the parties in the preparation of the submissions we propose to publish a Background Paper setting out the claims being pressed in Tranche 2, the submissions filed at paragraph [4] of the Commission's statement of 3 December 2019 (*December 2019 Statement*) and findings sought in respect of those claims. We anticipate that the Background Paper will be published in late December 2019.
- [2] Interested parties are to file written submissions in respect of the following matters by 4:00 pm on Friday 7 February 2020:
 - (a) whether they agree with or contest the findings sought by other interested parties in the written submissions listed at paragraph [4] of the *December 2019 Statement*;
 - (b) in respect of any submissions made in accordance with paragraph (a) above; the reasons for agreeing with or contesting the findings sought, by reference to the evidence;
 - (c) any submissions in reply to the written submissions listed at paragraph [4] of the *December 2019 Statement*;
 - (d) responses to the questions posed in the Background Paper; and

- (e) submissions in support of the parties preferred position on changes to the 24 hour clause as set out in the <u>Report</u> issued by Commissioner Lee on 14 November 2019 (Note: At [2019] FWCFB 6067, [104] we expressed the *provisional* view that a 24 hour clause be retained but that the existing clause does not provide a fair and relevant minimum safety net and required amendment).
- [3] Interested parties are to file any submissions in reply by 4:00 pm on Monday 24 February 2020.
- [4] Submissions are to be filed in Word format via email to amod@fwc.gov.au.
- [5] The matter will be listed for hearing on Wednesday 11 March 2020 at 9:30 am.
- [6] Interested parties are granted liberty to apply to vary these directions
