4 yearly review of modern awards - finalisation of exposure drafts - tranche 3 awards (AM2019/17)

The ANMF refers to the Decision of the Full Bench in the above matter dated 29 January 2020¹ and makes the following comments with respect to the '2020 Exposure Draft' and '2020 Draft Award Variation Determination' published on the same date.

The *Nurses Award 2010* (**Award**) is part of Tranche 3. With respect to the Award, the ANMF draws the attention of the Full Bench to the Australian Industry Group (**AI Group**) application AM2020/1 of 14 January 2020 to vary the Award in accordance with s157 and/or s160 of the *Fair Work Act 2009*. ⁴

Regarding the quantum of the casual loading payable, the AI Group seeks "a determination retrospectively varying" the Award so that it expressly requires, with respect to casual employees:

- (a) The Saturday and Sunday penalty rates prescribed by clause 26 of the Award are calculated on the minimum hourly rate prescribed by the Award and not on a rate that includes the separate casual loading prescribed by clause 10.4(b).
- (b) The overtime rates prescribed by clause 28 of the Award are calculated on the minimum hourly rate prescribed by the Award and not on a rate that includes the separate casual loading prescribed by clause 10.4(b).
- (c) The public holiday penalty rates prescribed by clause 32.1 of the Award are calculated on the minimum hourly rate prescribed by the Award and not on a rate that includes the separate casual loading prescribed by clause 10.4(b). ⁵

The AI Group application was partially in response to an ANMF submission of 13 June 2019⁶ concerning the version of the Exposure Draft of the Award published on 22 February 2019⁷. The ANMF submission concerned the interpretation of the Award in light of the Full Bench decision in *Opal*.⁸

The ANMF considers that it would be detrimental to all parties involved in matter AM2020/1 if the 2020 Exposure Draft and 2020 Draft Award Variation Determination proposed on 29 January 2020 are adopted prior to the outcome of AM2020/1. Consequently, we submit that the Award needs to maintain its current wording until AM2020/1 is determined, as the outcome of this matter will decide a number of contested entitlements in the Award.

Pursuant to Directions issued on 19 February 2020, AM2020/1 is listed for hearing on 1 September 2020. In the circumstances, the ANMF submits that the Award Exposure Draft should be removed from the matters for determination in the oral hearing listed on 6-7 April 2020.
