CFMMEU PROPOSED DIRECTIONS

1. The objection identified in paragraph 2 of the objections of the Construction Forestry Maritime Mining and Energy Union dated 30 September 2022 (the **Jurisdictional Objection**) is listed for hearing on [date in week of 5 December 2022], on an estimate of one day.
2. By 17 October 2022, the applicant must file and serve any affidavits on which he wishes to rely at the hearing of the Jurisdictional Objection, along with an outline of submissions of not more than 20 pages.
3. By 31 October 2022, the CFMMEU must file and serve any affidavits on which it wishes to rely at the hearing of the Jurisdictional Objection, along with an outline of submissions of not more than 20 pages.
4. By 14 November 2022, the applicant must file and serve any affidavits in reply on which he wishes to rely at the hearing of the Jurisdictional Objection, along with an outline of submissions in reply of not more than 10 pages.
