C2013/6333: Orders to The Trustees of the Roman Catholic Church for the Archdiocese of Canberra and Goulburn

We refer to the above proceedings, which are listed for an interlocutory hearing tomorrow, 24 April 2018.

Following discussions between our clients and the Trustees of the Roman Catholic Church for the Archdiocese of Canberra and Goulburn (**Archdiocese**), the Archdiocese has requested some minor

variations to the Orders issued by the Commission on the Archdiocese on 4 April 2018. A copy of the amended Orders proposed by the Archdiocese are attached (in markup).

Given the minor nature of the variations, our clients are willing to consent to these amended Orders being issued in place of the Orders made on 4 April 2018, should the Commission be minded to do so.

Timeframe for compliance with the amended Orders

The Archdiocese has further requested that it:

- provides documents that it holds at its offices by 26 April 2018; and
- provided any documents <u>held by St Joseph's O'Connor</u> by 7 May 2018.

While the delay in the provision of materials relating to St Joesph's O'Connor does not assist our clients' in terms of the timeframe for the filing and serving of their evidence and submissions, we are willing to also consent to this request on the basis that the school is currently unattended during school holidays.

Catholic Education Office (Sydney Catholic Schools)

We anticipate that the Catholic Education Office (now Sydney Catholic Schools Limited) will seek similar amendments to the Orders made on 4 April 2018 with respect to it. Our clients would not oppose a similar approach being taken with respect to the Orders issued to the Catholic Education Office.

We will endeavour to update the Commission regarding the Orders issued on the Catholic Education Office prior to the hearing tomorrow – as our office is continuing discussions with the Catholic Education Office.
