Casual terms award review 2021

SUPPLEMENTARY AMIEU SUBMISSIONS ON MEAT INDUSTRY AWARD 2020

- At the directions hearing on 16 August 2021, the Fair Work Commission (FWC) raised a potential inconsistency or interaction difficulty in relation to cl 12.8 of the *Meat Industry Award 2020* (Meat Award) in addition to those previously identified in the *August Decision*.¹ These submissions deal with this additional issue.
- 2. Clause 12.8 provides:

Wherever possible, the employer will notify casual employees of their starting and finishing times for the period of their engagement at the commencement of their engagement.

- 3. In the *July Decision*,² FWC expressed the *provisional* view that similar clauses in the Manufacturing Award and Pastoral Award requiring an employer to inform a casual employee of their hours of work upon engagement gave rise to an interaction difficulty with s 15A and should be deleted.
- 4. The AMIEU agrees that cl 12.8 raises similar issues and does not oppose FWC's *provisional* view that such clauses should be deleted.
