Expense-related allowances.

- A. Pursuant to s.157 of the *Fair Work Act 2009*, the above award is varied as follows:
1. By deleting the amount “\$16.53” appearing in clause 19.5(b)(i) and inserting “\$16.91”.
 2. By deleting the amount “\$13.23” appearing in clause 19.5(c) and inserting “\$13.54”.
 3. By deleting the amount “\$0.80” appearing in clause 19.6(a)(i) and inserting “\$0.91”.
 4. By deleting the amount “\$0.27” appearing in clause 19.6(a)(ii) and inserting “\$0.31”.
 5. By deleting the table appearing in clause C.2.1 and inserting the following:

Laundry allowance—Part-time or casual employee	19.4(d)(ii)	0.71	per shift

Vehicle allowance—Motorcycle	19.6(a)(ii)	0.31	per km

B. This determination comes into operation on 1 July 2022. In accordance with s.165(3) of the *Fair Work Act 2009* this determination does not take effect in relation to a particular employee until the start of the employee's first full pay period that starts on or after 1 July 2022.
