- A. Pursuant to s.157 of the *Fair Work Act 2009*, the above award is varied as follows:
1. By deleting the amount “\$1.97” appearing in clause 17.2(b) and inserting “\$1.98”.
  2. By deleting the amount “\$12.49” appearing in clause 17.3(a) and inserting “\$12.70”.
  3. By deleting the amount “\$0.85” appearing in clause 17.3(b)(i) and inserting “\$0.91”.
  4. By deleting the amount “\$0.28” appearing in clause 17.3(b)(ii) and inserting “\$0.30”.
  5. By deleting the table appearing in clause C.2.1 and inserting the following:
